Here are some fun activities you can have a go at:

Art and Crafts:

See if you can make yourself a teddy/troll/ bug hut! Challenge yourself to make it as cosy and interesting as possible so they'll want to move in.



Get moving!

Can you create your own **dance routine**? Choose your favourite song and see if you can figure out some new cool moves to teach your friends. Video it and send it in, if you like! 😊

MAZE MASTER - Create yourself a maze using items from your room/ sticks and leaves from the garden. Stand in the middle, close your eyes, spin around slowly twice and then try to find your way out! Someone else could try it to!

Hide and seek! Have someone hide three things around the house/garden, then see how long it takes you to find them! Can you get faster each time?

Writing

- Think of five **random words**! Write them down. They do not have to be connected at all. Now, see if you can write a funny story to tell somebody using each of those words.
- **Easter Bunny** - think of an origin story for it! Where did it come from? What is its mission? What is its motivation? Draw a comic strip to go with it.
- Look out of your window and write down four things that you see. Try to write a poem about each of them.
- How many Easter jokes can you create?

Maths

- **Times tables rock stars** awaits you! Practise makes perfect.
