Ways to Support Your Child

- Regular reading to and sharing books with your child. Can they make up their own stories?
- Play games with sounds e.g. finding objects beginning with a given sound, finding words that rhyme
- Talk to your child about what they have been learning at school
- Practise writing their name using the correct letter formation
- Count objects at any opportunity
- Talk about more and less e.g. If I had one more apple how many would there be?
- Can you go on a shape hunt around your house what shapes can you find?
- Talk about who helps them and how they help others.
