

Craft Instructions
Egg Box Bunny

## **Supplies**

- Coloured Card
- Glue Stick
- Two egg box segments
- Felt-tip pens
- Scissors
- Paint
- Googly eyes



Paint brushSmall pom-pom





**1** Trim the egg box segments so that there are no loose edges.



**5** Draw two ear shapes onto card, colour them in the same colour as the body of the bunny, and then cut them out.



**2** Add a small strip of card to one side of the egg box, leaving an overhang.



6 Draw two small feet from the left over card, colour them in then cut them out.



**3** Turn the second egg box segment upside down, then sit it on top of the first egg box segment, and attach them together using the strip of card.



**4** Paint the outside of both segments, then leave to dry.



7 Glue the feet onto the base of the bunny and the eyes onto the front. Finally, glue the ears onto the top of the bunny and a pom-pom tail on the back, then leave to dry.



8 Fill with tissue paper and small chocolate eggs or other treats.

**Step 6.** Draw two small feet from the left over card, colour them in then cut them out.

Glue the feet onto the base of the bunny and the eyes onto the front. Finally, glue the ears onto the top of the bunny and a pompom tail on the back, then leave to dry.



**Step 8.** Fill with tissue paper and small chocolate eggs or other treats.
