**STEP PYRAMID, SAQQARA**  
Built to be King Zoser's tomb, this first pyramid-like structure was erected in 2600 BC by the royal architect Imhotep. Nearby lie many other fine pyramids and tombs.

**OBELISK OF THUTMOSIS I, KARNAK**  
75 feet high, and 160 tons in weight, this obelisk was erected around 1530 BC during the Middle Kingdom. Some say it was once capped with gold.
