	Work through 1 - SPAG - Monday - Recognising Nouns PowerPoint. Then complete 1 - SPAG - Monday - Recognising Nouns Sheet 1	WALT Investigate the structure of a poem. Write down words you associate with: volcano, romans, history, autumn, season. Read the poem 'The Autumn Wind' (1 – ENGLISH – Monday – The Autumn Wind Poem). All poetry aside from Free Verse follows rules to do with rhythm and rhyme. This rhythm and rhyme helps create the feel of the poem. Look at the mixed up sentences of the poem 'The Sea' by James Reeves (1 – ENGLISH – Monday – The Sea Poem). Either cut them up and stick them in your book in the correct order, or re-write them out in the correct order.	Can you explain why you have chosen to put certain ideas together?	
	Work through 2 - SPAG - Tuesday - Recognising Nouns PowerPoint. Then complete 2 - SPAG - Tuesday - Recognising Nouns Sheet 2	WALT Use personification to describe an event. What is personification? Use a dictionary or the internet to find a definition and write it in your book. We are using 'The Sea' poem you looked at yesterday as inspiration to make your own volcano poem! Each verse in the poem talks about a different 'mood' shown by the sea. Look at the picture of a volcano (2 – ENGLISH – Tuesday – Volcano). Cut it out and stick it in your book. Write some descriptive phrases around the picture. If the volcano were a person, how would you describe their actions? Watch a video on an erupting volcano. Record sights and sounds in your book. How was it acting? What other descriptive phrases can you write down? Choose which animal your volcano is like and record descriptions that your volcano could do. Use 'The Sea' poem to help with ideas (2 – ENGLISH – Tuesday – The Sea Poem Completed - You will need this sheet for tomorrow as well!) Do not write your poem today!	Can you include in your plan: Expanded noun phrases Adverbial phrases Similes Personification Metaphors Look up examples and definitions of these if you are unsure of what they are!	
Wednesday	Work through 3 – SPAG – Wednesday – Recognising Pronouns PowerPoint. Then complete 3 – SPAG – Wednesday – Recognising Pronouns Sheet 1	Walt Write your own poem in the style of another. Re-read through 'The Sea' poem from yesterday. You are going to write your own volcano poem in the same style, showing the volcano as it moves from dormant (not erupting – asleep) to erupting. In the first verse of 'The Sea', the author is describing the sea as a dog. Your first verse needs to describe the volcano as your animal of choice. Use the ideas you wrote in your book yesterday, and the structure of 'The Sea' to help with ideas. Complete the first verse. Repeat the same with the second (waking up) and third (erupting) verses.	Can you edit your work? Add/remove/alter words to improve the rhythm or the rhymes. Try to make sure you include: Expanded noun phrases Adverbial phrases Similes Personification Metaphors Look up examples and definitions of these if you are unsure of what they are!
