Cost of SENCo for two days per week to coordinate support for pupils identified with SEND and those entitled to the Pupil Premium. To train staff, teachers and TAs, to deliver quality first teaching and a range of interventions to support identified pupils, ensuring accelerated progress and good outcomes.	£12, 800	Trained TAs will provide targeted small group and 1:1 support 3xweekly for SEN and Pupil Premium pupils across Key Stage 1 &2 focusing on core skills and nurturing. Reception & Year 1 TAs to receive Language Link training and a package of in-class follow-up, to support pupils with Speech & Language difficulties. Year 1 TA to be trained to deliver 'Starspell' IT spelling program to support Pupil Premium pupils not reaching their spelling targets then deliver program 3xweekly. TAs to be trained to deliver SNIP High Frequency Words. Year 3 TA to be trained to deliver AcceleRead/AccelerateWrite Wave 3 literacy initiative.

To buy in extra services to support vulnerable groups e.g. ESBAS & Play Therapy	£1, 500	ESBAS advisory teacher to observe and support specific group of vulnerable KS2 pupils with in-class and nurture support i.e. Circle Time activities. Play Therapy support 1 x weekly for two pupils.
Funding to allow pupils to take part in extra-curricular activities.	£3, 000	2 school trips per year for each pupil entitled to pupil premium @ £50 per child. Residential Trip for 5 x Year 6 children @ £500 per child.

Evaluation of Impact

Internal and external monitoring evidence all children entitled to the Pupil Premium make good progress. This year 100% of children entitled to the Pupil Premium achieved age related expectations or better at the end of Key Stage One and pupils entitled to the Pupil Premium make good progress across Key Stage Two.

OFSTED inspection July 2016 noted that:

“Disadvantaged pupils and pupils who have SEND and disabilities achieve as well as their peers from their different starting points.”
 “Over time, the school has been very successful in closing the gap between disadvantaged pupils and others in school and nationally. Never complacent, now leaders are focused in doing all that they can to close any gaps more quickly lower down the school...A leader has recently been charged with making sure that any support is properly personalized to meet individual pupils’ needs.”
