- Make sure you have used the correct punctuation for the cohesion of the story and ideas you are trying to give the reader.



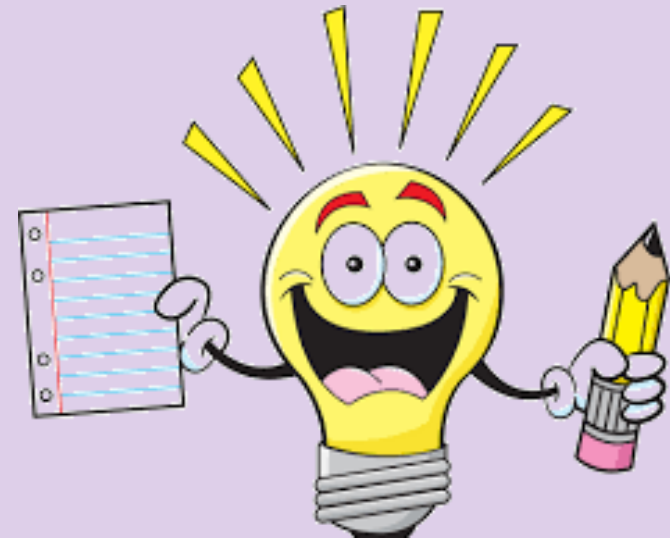

We must use the WILF whilst we read through our writing to edit - this can be: removing things, adding things in, changing vocabulary and punctuation.
