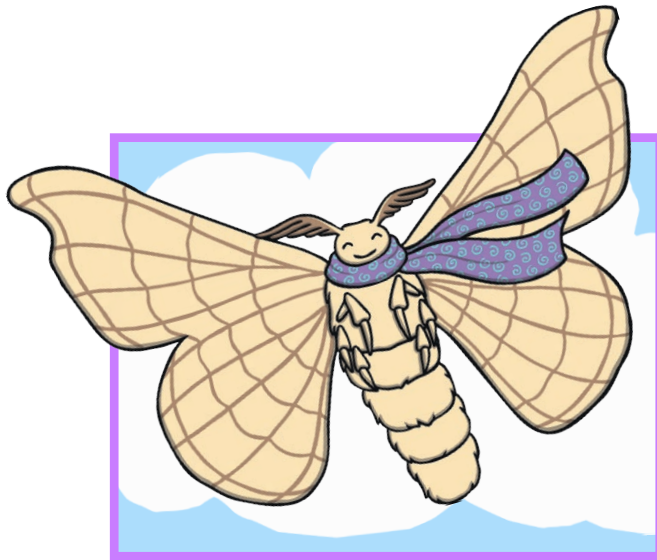

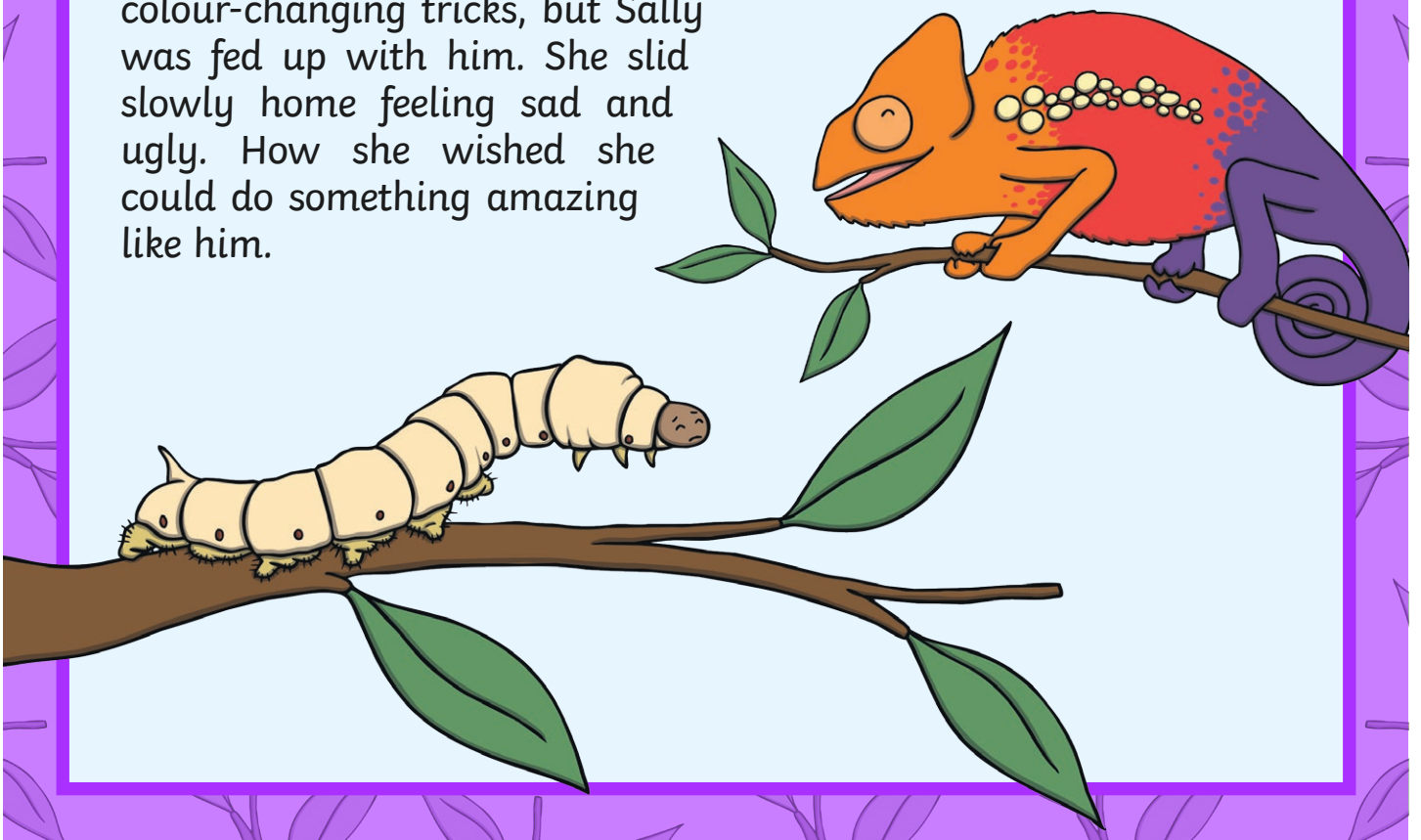
All Change!
