Ways to Support Your Child

- Regular reading and sharing books with your child.
- Provide opportunities for your child to write for a purpose can they help you write the shopping list/reminder note.
- Talk to your child about what they have been learning at school.
- Visit the library and help your to child choose an information book about an animal - what new information have they found out about their chosen animal?
- Talk about places you have visited together could be a city and a village what is
 similar/different or further afield e.g. a
 different country?
- If they have created something for example a model or painting can they share with you what they enjoyed about doing it, what they found tricky and how would they improve it should they do it again?
