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Friday	<p>SPAG warm up:</p> <p>What punctuation has Miss Doone missed?</p> <p>where is the butter asked dad</p>	<p>Today you are going to be writing a description of a section of the story.</p>	<p>You will need to either:</p> <p>1. Type onto/above/beside the picture on Seesaw or 2. Handwrite your work and upload it to SeeSaw.</p> <p>You need to write at least 5 sentences describing the picture.</p> <p>Think about...</p> <p>How is Augustus feeling?</p> <p>What can you see in the picture?</p> <p>Remember you can watch Miss Doone reading the story to help you, and use your excellent describing skills!</p>	<p>Challenge: Use the voice recording section of SeeSaw to read Miss Doone your description!</p>
