

Supplies

- Coloured card
- Cotton wool
- Pencil
- Glue Stick

- A rabbit coloured shade of wool



- Googly eyes

Fold a sheet of A4 card to make a greetings card.



Stick cotton wool to fill the inside of the bunny's ears, then leave to dry.



Draw two circles, one on top of the other to form a body and head for a bunny. Also draw two ears at the top of the smaller circle.



Use a felt pen to draw on top of the pencil outline to make it stand out.



Cut lengths of wool long enough to fill inside the circle shapes.



Stick googly eyes to the face and pom-poms for the tail.



Begin to glue the wool inside the bunny shape you have drawn. This could be in any pattern you choose, ensuring the whole area is covered.



8 Once dry, write a message inside the card.
