Expressive Art & Design

Singing a variety of songs
Detailed line drawings of flowers
Painting flowers (e.g. daffodils, spring flowers)
Printing with different vegetables,
Collage - making beanstalks and patterns
Role Play/Dance - Jack and the Beanstalk
Singing
Using instruments to represent Jack and the Giant

Communication, Language and Literacy

Handwriting and letter formation
Letters and sounds - consolidating sounds, blending and segmenting words
Continue to develop 'have a go' writing,
Use correct sounds for words, leave finger spaces, use capital letters for the beginning of a sentence
Reading Jack and the Beanstalk, role playing the characters and events
Listening to other stories about growing
Talk for Writing - how to grow a beanstalk
Information Writing - plants, growing a beanstalk
