### **Easter Chick**

#### You will need:

Orange, light yellow and white card

Chick template

Yellow and orange paint

A sponge

Feathers

PVA glue

#### Instructions

- 1. Draw around the chick template onto either light yellow card or white card, then cut out the template.
- 2. Using a sponge dipped in yellow or orange paint, sponge print the chick's body and head until covered. then leave to dry.
- 3. Use PVA glue to stick 3 or 4 feathers onto the back of the chick; these should be positioned to look like wings.







- 4. Draw and cut out a diamond shape from the orange card. Fold along the middle to create a triangle shaped beak.
- 5. Using PVA glue stick the beak onto the chicks face.
- 6. Using a felt pen draw eyes on the chick.













#### You will need:

Orange, light yellow and white card

Chick template

Yellow and orange paint

A sponge

Feathers

PVA glue









Draw around the chick template onto either light yellow card or white card, then cut out the template.
