CAPITAL LETTERS, FULL STOPS AND ADJECTIVES REMINDER

We will be using facts in our writing. You might be using quite short sentences so it is important that we use capital letters and full stops to show where a sentence starts and finishes.

Starter: Write out the alphabet in capital letters ABCDEFGHIJKLMNOPQRSTUVWXYZ Can you write out these sentences putting in the capital letters and full stops?

Example:

Giraffe's have long necks to help them reach the top of tall trees.

The burning hot sun comes out more in the Summer.

Miss Blackwell owns a small, black car which she drives along windy roads to get to school.
