# Fox

## What do they look like?

The fox has reddish-brown fur, a white chest and a bushy, white-tipped tail, called a brush. Its nose and ears are pointed. They are roughly the size of a medium sized dog.

## What do they eat?

A fox is an omnivore which means it will eat pretty much anything. They are scavengers will eat anything they can find, including insects, earthworms, fruit, berries, birds, small mammals and scraps left by humans. They normally hunt for food during the night time.

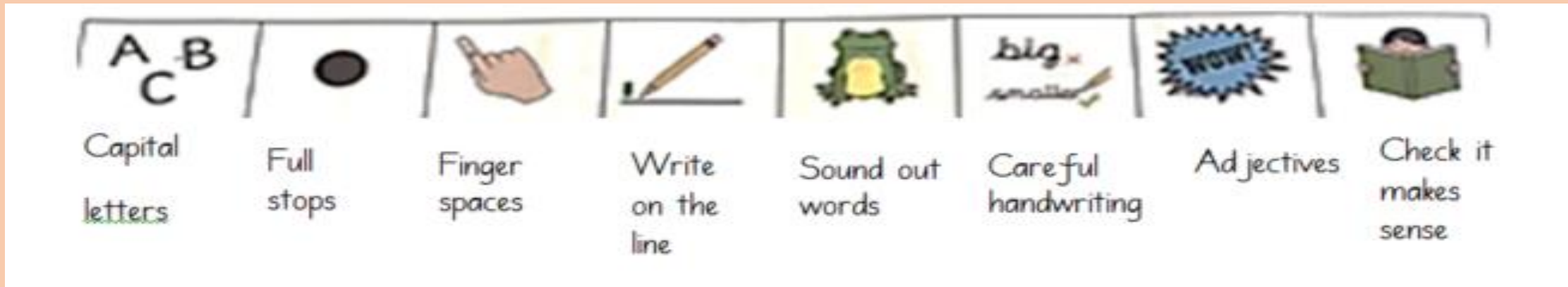
## What do they live?
