The following is a carousel of activities for you to choose from. Aim to complete 1 a day. You do not have to complete all of the activities – you may choose to repeat activities 1 and 5 instead of doing some of the other activities.

<p><b><u>Activity 1 (can be done multiple times)</u></b></p> <p><i>Go to the <b>Pobble 365</b> webpage and choose an image to use as a story starter. You may choose to do this several times this week as your English lesson. I am always happy to receive stories by email to read, or you may instead choose to share them with your family.</i></p>	<p><b><u>Activity 2</u></b></p> <p>This is a double session as it can be spread over two days. Write a biography of someone you know. It may be a member of your household or a different family member or friend. Start by compiling a list of questions. Think carefully about your questions; this is a great opportunity to find out more about someone you already know well. Next, interview your chosen person. This may be done in person, on Skype or by email! Finally, look at the answers you get back and plan and write your biography. Remember to adhere to the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1, Use past tense</li><li>2, ensure it's in chronological order.</li><li>3, Consider your audience and choose your language accordingly.</li></ol>
