| Play Therapist to support vulnerable groups | £4,000 | Play Therapy support 1x weekly for four pupils |
| Educational Psychologist to support vulnerable groups. | £1,500 | To buy in package of Educational Psychologist support for vulnerable groups. |
| Funding to allow pupils entitled to Pupil Premium to take part in Year 6 Residential Trip. | £1,500 | Residential trip for 3 x Year 6 pupils @ £400 per child. |
| Funding to allow pupils to take part in extra-curricular activities. | £2,000 | 2 school trips per year for each pupil entitled to Pupil Premium. |
| Staff Training | £3,000 | Staff training on INSET on quality first teaching, support for disadvantaged and vulnerable groups. |
