

Western Road Community Primary School SATS Results 2015 – 2016

Key Stage 1 SATS:

The National Curriculum is organised into Key Stages. Attainment and progress are measured across each Key Stage. Key Stage One comprises learners in Years One and Two (ages 5 to 7). In the second half of the Summer Term, Year Two children are assessed as to how well they perform in reading, writing and maths, both against national standards and against our own high standards.

Key Stage 2 SATS:

KS2 comprises pupils in Years 3 - 6 (ages 7 to 11). At end of Year 6, children achieving the expected standard are performing at an age expected standard. Children performing at level 5 are performing above the age expected standard.
