Developing Explain if the statement correctly identifies the type of noun used in a single-clause sentence. Includes common and proper nouns.

Expected Explain if the statement correctly identifies the type of noun used in a multiclause sentence with coordination. Includes common, proper, collective and abstract nouns.

Greater Depth Explain if the statement correctly identifies the type of noun used in a multiclause sentence with subordination. More than one noun per sentence. Includes various types of noun.
