#### Last Year's Results

At the meeting I was very pleased to share the school's end of Year 2015 results with governors. This set of data shows the percentage of children who achieved a Good Level of Development in the Reception Class, the percentage of children who met or exceeded the expected standard in the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check and the percentage of children who were working at age related expectations or above in Year 2 (Level 2) and in Year 6 (Level 4).
