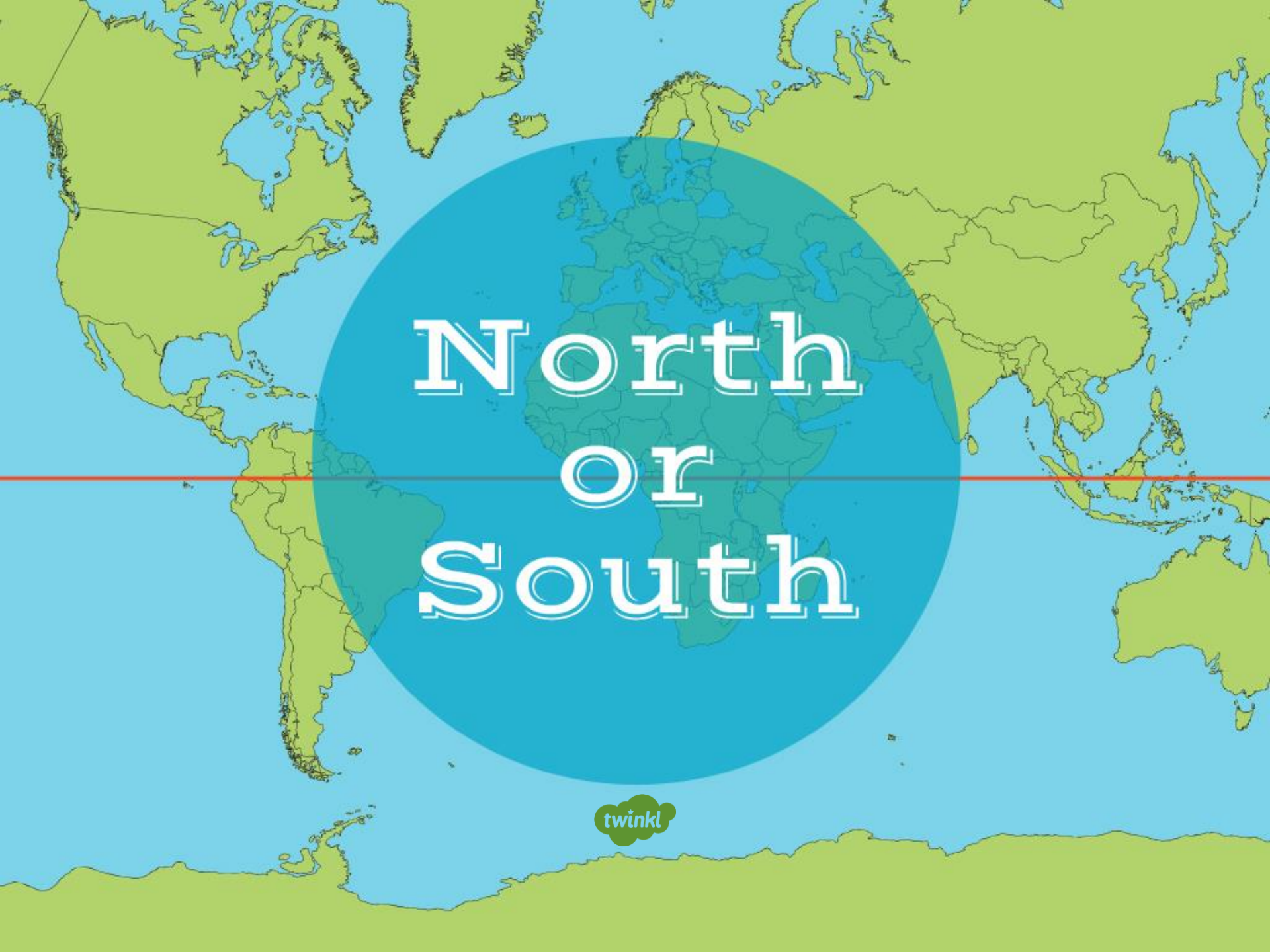

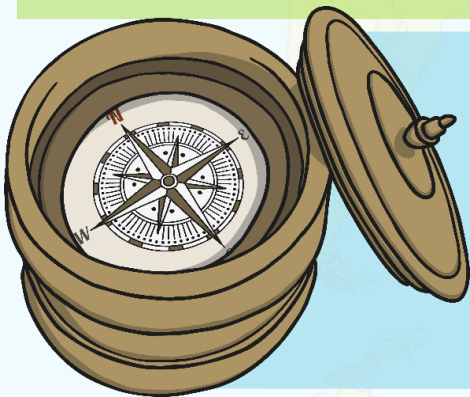
Top or Bottom?

The top part is the **Northern Hemisphere**.

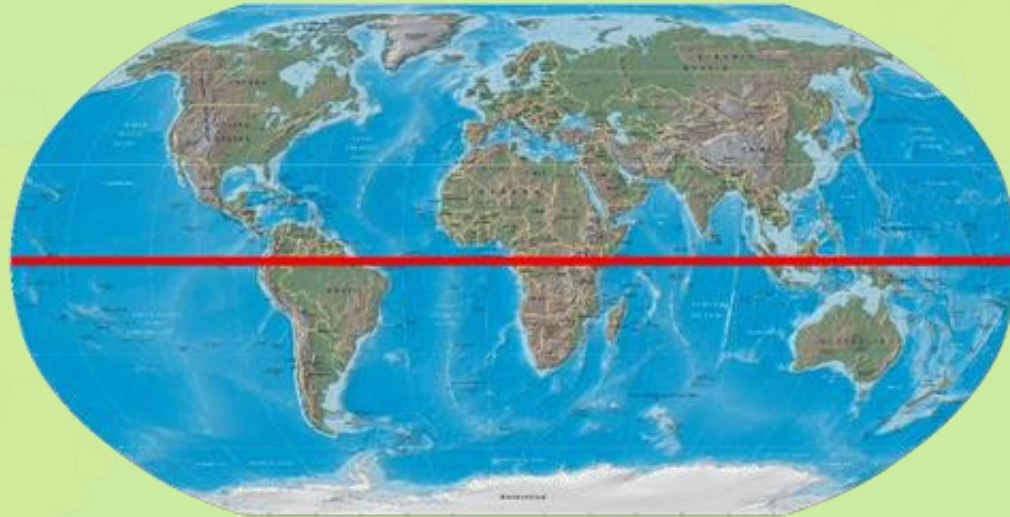
The bottom part is the **Southern Hemisphere**.

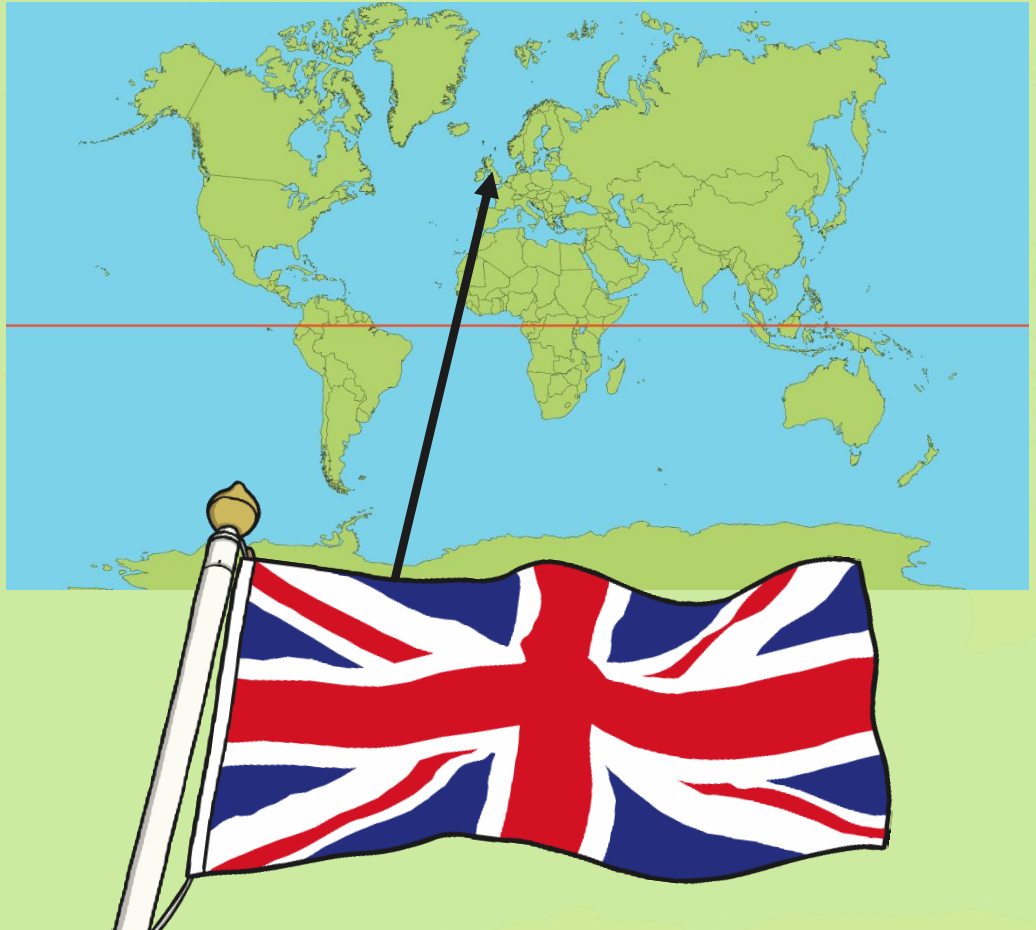
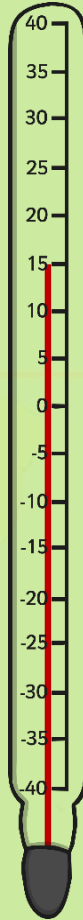

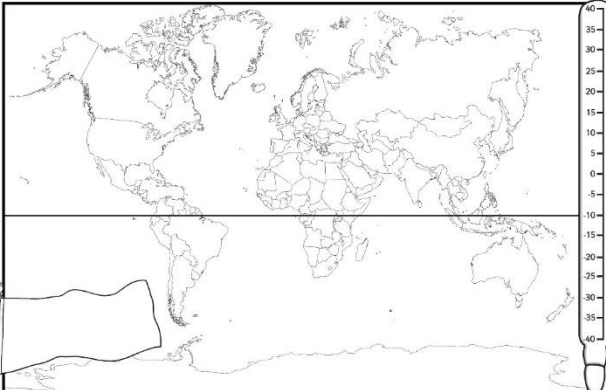
