Pom Pom Animals

You will need: Several colours of wool Scissors Coloured card Felt pens Pom pom animal templates



Instructions

- 1. Choose an animal template and draw around this twice onto coloured card.
- 2. Cut out both animal templates. Then put them together back to back.
- 3. Choose some coloured wool and pull one end of it through the hole in the middle. Then loop it back over and secure in a knot.
- 4. Wrap the wool around the ring on the animal by threading it through the hole, over the outer rim, and then back through the hole. Continue until all of the body of the animal is wrapped in wool. Make sure that the head and feet are still free.









Pom Pom Animals

- 5. Slide a pair of scissors between the two animal shaped cards; keep your fingers on either side in the middle of the circle and begin cutting the wool.. Continue until you have cut all the way around the outside of the circle.
- 6. Then cut a length of wool and carefully slide it around the wool between the card pieces and tie securely in a double knot.
- 7. Tie the extra string into a loop from which the pom-pom animal can hang.
- 8. Using a black felt tip pen, draw facial features onto the animals.
