News From School Council

It has been a busy and productive year for the School Council and I would like to thank Charlie, Rianna, George, Woody, Elieh, Lola, Orson, Daniel and Abby for all their hard work and contributions.

The children have participated in a number of important discussions and decisions and we just wanted to summarise them here so you know what a valuable job they do.

Early on in the academic year we took a trip to Lewes Town Council where they met the Mayor and the Deputy Mayor. They received a tour and held a mock Council session. This was very much enjoyed by children and parents, and was a valuable lesson in how a real life Council session was run.

We have taken part in a range of fundraising this year, one of which being Children in Need, where the School Council decided what we were going to do as a school to raise money. Just a reminder that this raised a brilliant total of £180.

Later on in the year, the children collaborated with Mr Montebello and myself on the revised Behaviour Policy, which included creating their own child-friendly version. This would not have been possible without their contributions and brilliant ideas! They have also supported with the current class Art Projects helping to decide what the theme would be.

And finally, they have begun a long term project focused on Reducing Plastics at school. As well as some other selected children, the School Council took part in a workshop at the Linklater Pavilion where we learnt all about how

plastics affect the environment and what we can do to help. From this, we have produced a four point long-term action plan for our school:

- 1. Introduce mixed recycling e.g. plastic bottles, cardboard, paper etc. (We have already received our mixed recycling bins and will begin to use them in September.)
- 2. Reduce the use of single use plastic bottles school lunches, buy multi-use bottles etc.
- 3. Introduce Plastic Free Friday once a termly / bi-termly.
- 4. Organise a school beach clean.

This has been a great start to this project and make sure you keep a look out for more on this next academic year.
