

## **Easter Box Chick**

#### **Supplies**

- Coloured Card
- Glue Stick
- Two egg box segments
- Scissors
- Yellow paint
- Googly eyes
- Paint brush







**1** Trim the egg box segments so that there are no loose edges.



6 Cut out the triangle.



Stick a small strip of card to one side of the egg box, leaving an overhang.



**7** Draw two small feet from the left **over card and cut out**.



- **3** Turn the second egg box segment upside down, then sit it on top of the first egg box segment, and attach them together using the strip of card.
- 4
- Paint the outside of both segments

yellow, then leave to dry.



8 Now glue all of the features onto the egg box chick; first glue the feet onto the base and the eyes onto the front. Then open the chick and glue the wings and beak on, then leave to dry.



Fill with tissue paper and small chocolate eggs or other treats.



5 Now make the beak for the chick. To do this, fold a piece orange card, then draw a triangle, making sure that it is against the fold.
