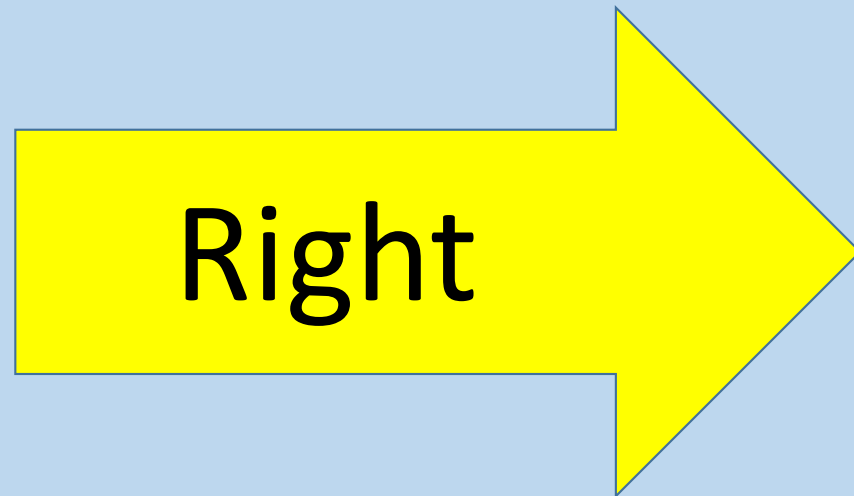
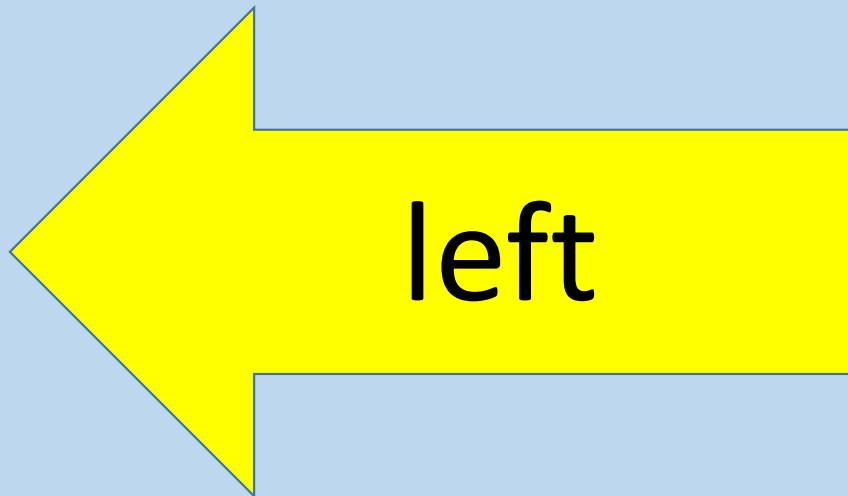

WALT – give directions

To be able to give directions you will need
to know your left and right really well



Learning/practising left and right activities

1. Simon says (jump to the left)
2. Tie something to each wrist and get someone to ask you to hold up either right or left if you get it right you get a point.
3. Have 2 chairs out in front of you place something different on each one and ask your child to tell you what is on the left one etc How many are on the right one..
4. Dance to the hockey cockey 'you put your left arm in your left arm out in out in out you shake it all about' (video/music on youtube)
