Use of the playground after school

At a recent meeting of the Parent Forum we discussed the issue of keeping the playground open after school. These arrangements were introduced a year ago and at the Parent Forum we agreed to review them regularly. Please see the basis on which the playground is kept open below:

- 1) The playground is open to Western Road children from 3.30pm to 4pm, unless there is an after school club using the playground at this time.
- 2) Children using the playground after 3.30pm must be closely supervised by their parents at all times. The school cannot be responsible for supervising children using the playground after 3.30pm. Parents should be aware that the play equipment in the junior playground is not designed for pre-school children. Any parents allowing children to use this equipment after 3.30pm do so at their own risk.
- 3) Children and families must remain in the far playground (junior playground), thus minimising any noise because meetings often take place in classrooms after school.

Safe-Guarding Children at Western Road Community Primary School: At Western Road Community Primary, all staff take safeguarding children very seriously. All staff have been trained in Safeguarding and Child Protection. If you have any concerns about a child's well-being, bullying or e-safety, please contact the Designated Teachers for Child Protection: Mr Montebello, Mr Paterson and Mrs Wooler.

- 4) Children must refrain from using their bikes and scooters in the playground during this time, thus minimising the risk of accidents since the school will not be open. (Obviously if a child is seriously injured we would expect you to come to the school for assistance).
- 5) Children do not return to school for any reason, such as to use the toilet or to collect items. The school closes at 3.30pm and staff are not available after this time to supervise/escort children or adults to the toilet or around the building, which we must do to comply with safeguarding and child protection procedures.

I trust that you will appreciate the reasons for these requests and thank you for cooperating with the school in this matter.
