Yeast is a micro-organism that is used in bread to make it rise.

When the yeast feeds on the dough, it produces gas which forms air bubbles in the bread. Yeast is put in bread and it eats the dough but what does yeast most like to eat? Is there anything else that yeast loves? Follow the steps in this experiment to find out.



You will need:

- 6 plastic cups
- Water
- Measuring jug
- Weighing scales
- 6 sachets of yeast (7g)
- 6 ziplock bags
- •20g salt
- •20g sugar
- 20g flour
- 20g rice
- •20g coffee •20g oil
