Home learning tasks-guide for grown ups- 2.4.20
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Please DO NOT feel like you have to do all of these tasks every day. Some days you might do all of them and some days you may not do any. These are just some ideas to keep you going for when your child ready and happy to learn.

<u>Phonics</u>

Play hide the sound! Write ch,sh,ng,th,ai,ar,or onto postit notes or small pieces or paper and hide them around your living room! Can you find them and say them before a 3 minute timer runs out? Heres a link to show you how to pronounce the sounds- https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-ksblMiliA8

Draw a box split into 3 sections. Try to get your child to write ship, park and rain. If you can think of some more words with the above diagraphs in, then

you could do some more.

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Maths

Look at the link above and do I activity per day from 'week I.' If you do not have the resources they ask for then don't worry, you could improvise for example instead of plastic eggs you could make playdough eggs.

Reading

If you have some suitable books at home, then try to read once a day with your child. Give them LOADS of praise and encouragement. If you want, you could video them reading and upload it onto tapestry so that we can give your child some positive feedback!

<u>Writing</u>

Can you write a speech bubble from The Bear hunt? For example- you could draw a picture of one of the children and write "What a beautiful day!" Don't expect the children to spell each word correctly; try to get them to make a phonetically plausible attempt. For example- "Wot a booteefl dai" Try and get them to remember a capital letter at the start and a full stop at the end.
