News from Willow Class

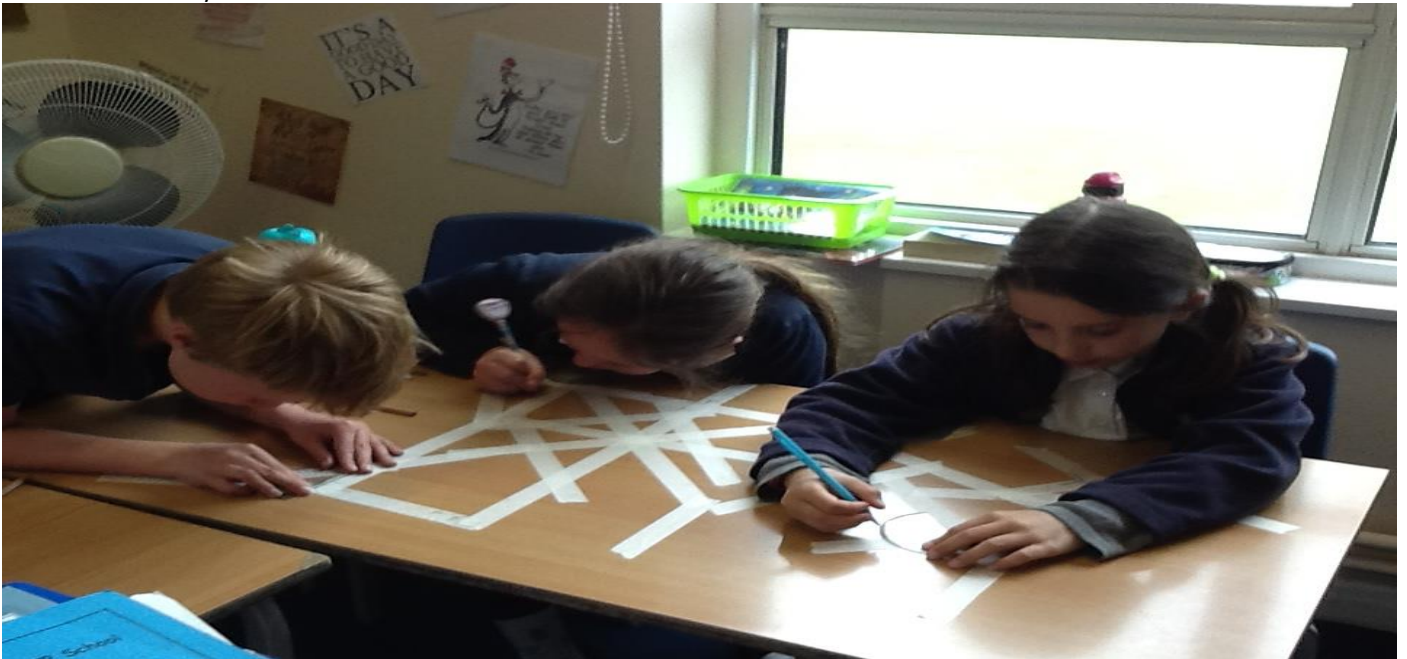
