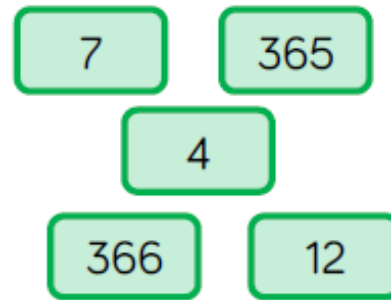
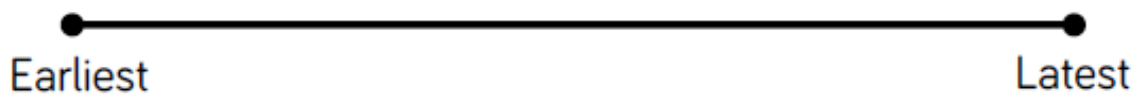

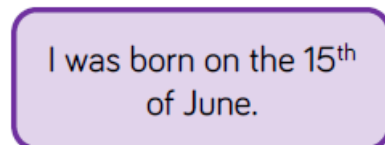


4 children describe their birthdays.

My birthday is the first day of the second month.



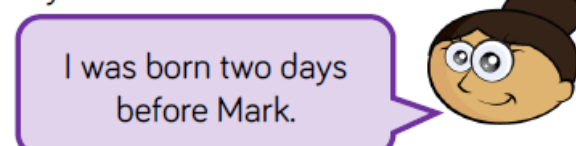
Sam
