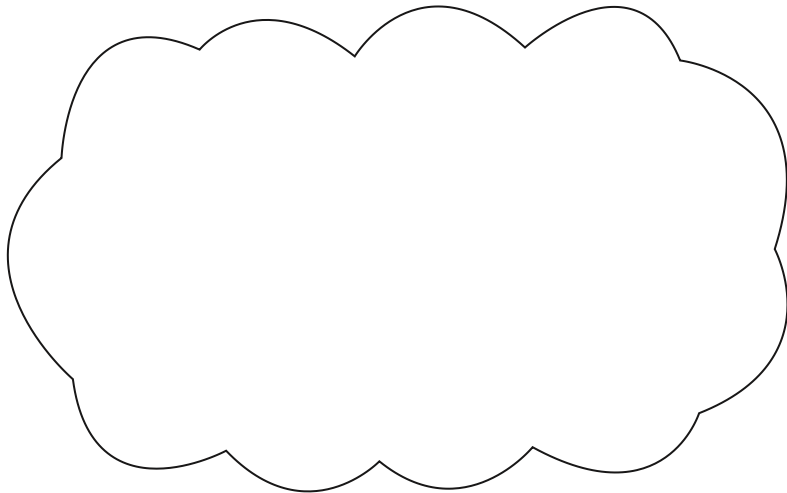


Q1 Megan says, “If I can work out the total of 534 and 275 in my head, I can work out the total of 5,340 and 2,750 in my head.”
